

Rochdale Canal Towpath & Access Improvement Scheme

Start Date: 10th May 2010

Duration: Approx. 3 weeks

Aims

- To clear and upgrade the surface of the towpath to a multi-user standard for all users including walkers, cyclists, wheelchair users, buggies etc.
- Improve access on to the canal at key points and include signage to inform users of other potential users.

Phase 1 will work on the stretch from Wrigley Head to Failsworth District Centre.
